Mr. MITCHELL (for himself and Mr. DOLE) submitted the following resolution;
which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

To authorize the production of records by the Committee
on Governmental Affairs

Whereas, the Committee on Governmental Affairs has conducted an investigation of serious management problems at the National Archives and Record Administration;

Whereas, as a result of its investigation, the Committee referred matters that it had investigated to executive branch agencies for investigation and appropriate action;

Whereas, the Department of Justice has requested access to records of the Committee's investigation as part of the inquiry resulting from the Committee's referral;

Whereas, by the privileges of the Senate of the United States and rule XI of the Standing Rules of the Senate, no evidence under the control or in the possession of the Sen-

ate can, by administrative or judicial process, be taken from such control or possession but by permission of the Senate; and

Whereas, when it appears that evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate is needed for the promotion of justice, the Senate will take such action as will promote the ends of justice consistent with the privileges of the Senate: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Chairman and Ranking Minority
2 Member of the Committee on Governmental Affairs, act-
3 ing jointly, are authorized to provide to the Department
4 of Justice records of testimony and exhibits received by
5 the Committee in its investigation of management prob-
6 lems at the National Archives and Records Administra-
7 tion, except for materials for which a privilege should be
8 asserted.
