## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

To congratulate the Republic of China on Taiwan on the occasion of its first direct and democratic presidential election and the inauguration of its president.

Whereas March 23, 1996, was the first time in the history of the Republic of China on Taiwan that a presidential election was held through direct popular vote by the people of Taiwan;

Whereas the election was held under great difficulties caused by extensive military threats from the People's Republic of China; and

1	Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
2	concurring), That—
3	(1) the Congress congratulates the people of
4	Taiwan on holding their first direct and democratic

6	(2) the United States continues its commitment
7	to move nations toward freedom and democracy; and
8	(3) the United States is committed to encourag-
9	ing and protecting its democratic friends on Taiwan,
10	within the framework of the Taiwan Relations Act.
