## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Commending the entities which were instrumental in developing the “Friday Night Live” and “Club Live” programs and which have created, are operating, and are working to expand the “Rotary Life Club” program.

Whereas in 1975 the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Council of Contra Costa County, California (referred to herein as “ADAC”) was incorporated as a California non-profit public benefit corporation with the mission of prevention and treatment of drug and alcohol abuse in young adults;

Whereas in 1983 the Rotarians Against Substance Abuse Foundation (referred to herein as “RASAF”) was incorporated by 13 Rotary Clubs in Contra Costa County, California, including the Rotary Clubs of Martinez, Concord, and Pleasant Hill, as a California non-profit public

benefit corporation with a mission similar to that of ADAC;

Whereas since 1975, ADAC has been instrumental in developing “Friday Night Live” and “Club Live”, two on-campus peer programs managed by the State of California that are designed to prevent alcohol and drug abuse, respectively by high school students and middle school students;

Whereas since 1983 RASAF has also been instrumental in developing the Friday Night Live and Club Live programs;

Whereas the Rotary Club of Concord and the First Presbyterian Church of Concord created the first off-campus Friday Night Live program, now known as “Rotary Life Clubs”, and have operated “Rotary Life Club #1” (also known as “Friday Night Live Club #1”) since 1990 as a club where high school students can participate in community service projects and other fun events without the use of drugs or alcohol;

Whereas the partnership of RASAF, ADAC, the Rotary Club of Concord, and the First Presbyterian Church of Concord is one of the finest examples of private sector entities cooperating to provide substance abuse prevention programs for young people which emphasize community service and fun events; and

Whereas RASAF is working with the Salus International Health Institute and 26,000 Rotary Clubs in 170 countries to expand the Rotary Life Club concept throughout the world: Now, therefore, be it
