## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for the appointment of Anne D'Harnoncourt as  
a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithso-  
nian Institution.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-  
4       utes of the United States (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on  
5       the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution, in  
6       the class other than Members of Congress, occurring by  
7       reason of the expiration of the term of Samuel Curtis  
8       Johnson of Wisconsin on December 4, 1995, is filled by  
9       the appointment of Anne D'Harnoncourt of Pennsylvania.

- 1 The appointment is for a term of six years and shall take
- 2 effect on December 5, 1995.
