Res. 132) entitled "Joint resolution affirming that budget negotiations shall be based on the most recent technical and economic assumptions of the Congressional Budget Office and shall achieve a balanced budget by fiscal year 2002 based on those assumptions" do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Amend the preamble as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 2, strike out [Office] and insert: Office,
- 2 and the President and the Congress agree that the balanced
- 3 budget must protect future generations, ensure medicare sol-
- 4 vency, reform welfare, and provide adequate funding for
- 5 medicaid, education, agriculture, national defense, veterans,
- 6 and the environment. Further, the balanced budget shall
- 7 adopt tax policies to help working families and to stimulate
- 8 future economic growth
