Mr. DORNAN introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

JOINT RESOLUTION

To establish a joint committee to oversee the conduct of Operation Joint Endeavor/Task Force Eagle.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That a joint committee be appointed to inquire into the
4 conduct of Operation Joint Endeavor/Task Force Eagle,
5 vested with power to send for papers and persons and to
6 sit during sessions of either House of Congress.

7 The joint committee shall be comprised of the chair-
8 man of the House National Security Committee, each of
9 the respective chairmen of each of the several subcommit-
10 tees of the House National Security Committee, the rank-

1 ing member of the House National Security Committee
2 plus two additional members appointed by the ranking
3 member, the chairman of the House Permanent Select
4 Committee on Intelligence and the ranking member of the
5 House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, the
6 chairman of the House International Relations Commit-
7 tee, the ranking member of the House International Rela-
8 tions Committee, the chairman of the Senate Armed Serv-
9 ices Committee, the respective chairmen of each of the sev-
10 eral subcommittees of the Senate Armed Services Commit-
11 tee, the ranking member of the Senate Armed Services
12 Committee plus two additional members appointed by the
13 ranking member, the chairman of the Senate Select Com-
14 mittee on Intelligence and the ranking member of the Sen-
15 ate Select Committee on Intelligence, the chairman of the
16 Senate Foreign Relations Committee, and the ranking
17 member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee.

18 The joint committee shall be cochaired by the chair-
19 man of the House National Security Committee and the
20 chairman of the Senate Armed Services Committee.
