JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to permit the Congress to limit contributions and expenditures in elections for Federal office.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled (two-
- 3 thirds of each house concurring therein), That the following
- 4 article is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution
- 5 of the United States, which shall be valid to all intents
- 6 and purposes as part of the Constitution when ratified by
- 7 the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States with-
- 8 in seven years from the date of its submission by the Con-
- 9 gress:

- 2 "Section 1. The Congress shall have the power to
- 3 set limits on expenditures made by, in support of, or in
- 4 opposition to the nomination or election of any person to
- 5 Federal office.
- 6 "Section 2. The Congress shall have the power to
- 7 set limits on contributions by individuals or entities by,
- 8 in support of, or in opposition to the nomination or elec-
- 9 tion of any person to Federal office.
- 10 "Section 3. The Congress shall have the power to
- 11 enforce, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this
- 12 article.".
