3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Highway Mandates
5 Repeal Act of 1995”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF USE OF ASPHALT PAVEMENT CONTAIN-**
2 **ING RECYCLED RUBBER.**
