## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Commerce to convey to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts the National Marine Fisheries Service laboratory located on Emerson Avenue in Gloucester, Massachusetts.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF NATIONAL MARINE FISH-
2	ERIES SERVICE LABORATORY AT GLOUCES-
3	TER, MASSACHUSETTS.
4	(a) Conveyance Required.—
5	(1) In general.—The Secretary of Commerce
6	shall convey to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
7	all right, title, and interest of the United States in
8	and to the property comprising the National Marine
9	Fisheries Service laboratory located on Emerson
10	Avenue in Gloucester, Massachusetts.
11	(2) Terms.—A conveyance of property under
12	paragraph (1) shall be made—
13	(A) without payment of consideration; and
14	(B) subject to the terms and conditions
15	specified under subsections (b) and (c).
16	(b) Conditions for Transfer.—
17	(1) In General.—As a condition of any convey-
18	ance of property under this section, the Common-
19	wealth of Massachusetts shall assume full responsibil-
20	ity for maintenance of the property for as long as the
21	Commonwealth retains the rights and title to that
22	property.
23	(2) Continued use of property by NMFS.—
24	The Secretary may enter into a memorandum of un-
25	derstanding with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
26	under which the National Marine Fisheries Service is

1	authorized to occupy existing laboratory space on the
2	property conveyed under this section, if—
3	(A) the term of the memorandum of under-
4	standing is for a period of not longer than 5
5	years beginning on the date of enactment of this
6	Act; and
7	(B) the square footage of the space to be oc-
8	cupied by the National Marine Fisheries Service
9	does not conflict with the needs of, and is agree-
10	able to, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
11	(c) Reversionary Interest.—All right, title, and
12	interest in and to all property and interests conveyed under
13	this section shall revert to the United States on the date
14	on which the Commonwealth of Massachusetts uses any of
15	the property for any purpose other than the Commonwealth
16	of Massachusetts Division of Marine Fisheries resource
17	management program.
18	(d) Restriction.—Amounts provided by the South
19	Essex Sewage District may not be used by the Common-
20	wealth of Massachusetts to transfer existing activities to, or
21	conduct activities at, property conveyed under this section.
