A BILL

1	SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AT
2	NAVAL WEAPONS INDUSTRIAL RESERVE
3	PLANT, CALVERTON, NEW YORK, FOR USE AS
4	NATIONAL CEMETERY.
5	(a) Transfer Authorized.—Notwithstanding sec-
6	tion 2854 of the Military Construction Authorization Act
7	for Fiscal Year 1993 (division B of Public Law 102–484)
8	106 Stat. 2626), the Secretary of the Navy may transfer
9	without reimbursement, to the Secretary of Veterans Af-
10	fairs a parcel of real property consisting of approximately
11	150 acres located adjacent to the Calverton National Cem-
12	etery, Calverton, New York, and comprising a portion of
13	the buffer zone of the Naval Weapons Industrial Reserve
14	Plant, Calverton.
15	(b) Use of Property.—The Secretary of Veterans
16	Affairs shall use the real property transferred under sub-
17	section (a) as an addition to the Calverton National Ceme-
18	tery and administer such real property pursuant to chap-
19	ter 24 of title 38, United States Code.
20	(c) Surveys.—The cost of any surveys necessary for
21	the transfer of jurisdiction of the real property described
22	in subsection (a) from the Secretary of the Navy to the
23	Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall be borne by the Sec-
24	retary of Veterans Affairs.
