3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States Post Office building located at
5 1203 Lemay Ferry Road, St. Louis, Missouri, shall be
6 known and designated as the “Charles J. Coyle Post Of-
7 fice Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
4 States Post Office building referred to in section 1 shall
5 be deemed to be a reference to the “Charles J. Coyle Post
6 Office Building”.
