A BILL

To amend the National Security Act of 1947 to establish the positions of Director, Deputy Director, and Senior Directors of the National Security Council and to require that their appointments be subject to confirmation by the Senate, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF POSITIONS OF DIRECTOR,**
2 **DEPUTY DIRECTOR, AND SENIOR DIRECTORS**
3 **OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (c) of section 101 of
5 the National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 402) is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 “(c)(1) The Council shall have a director and a dep-
8 uty director, both of whom shall be appointed by the Presi-
9 dent, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate.

10 “(2) The Council may have such additional senior di-
11 rectors as the President determines necessary. Such senior
12 directors shall be appointed by the President, by and with
13 the consent of the Senate.

14 “(3) The director may appoint and fix the compensa-
15 tion of such additional personnel as may be necessary to
16 perform such duties as may be prescribed by the Council
17 in connection with the performance of its functions.

18 “(4) The director, deputy director, senior directors,
19 and such additional personnel shall be appointed subject
20 to the provisions of title 5, United States Code, governing
21 appointments in the competitive service, and shall be paid
22 in accordance with the provisions of chapter 51 and sub-
23 chapters III and VIII of chapter 53 of that title relating
24 to classification and General Schedule and Senior Execu-
25 tive Service pay rates.”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section shall take effect on the date of the enactment
3 of this Act and shall apply with respect to any individual
4 serving on such date in one of the following positions: the
5 Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs,
6 the Deputy Assistant to the President for National Secu-
7 rity Affairs, and any Special Assistant to the President
8 and Senior Director of the National Security Council.
