To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the minimum wage.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE.**

4 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor
5 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 “(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-
8 tion, not less than \$4.75 an hour;”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) shall take effect on the first day of the 3rd

1 month beginning after the date of the enactment of this
2 Act.
