Mr. GILMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To amend section 3 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 to more accurately determine the median income for Rockland County, New York, for purposes of housing programs administered by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DETERMINATION OF INCOME LIMITS.**

4 That section 3(b)(2) of the United States Housing Act
5 of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437a(b)(2)) is amended—

6 (1) in the 4th sentence—

1 (A) by striking “County” and inserting
2 “and Rockland Counties”; and

3 (B) by inserting “each” before “such coun-
4 ty”; and

5 (2) in the last sentence—

6 (A) by striking “County” the 1st place it
7 appears and inserting “or Rockland Counties”;
8 and

9 (B) by striking “County” the 2d place it
10 appears and inserting “and Rockland Coun-
11 ties”.

12 **SEC. 2. REGULATIONS AND EFFECTIVE DATE.**

13 The Secretary of Housing and Urban Development
14 shall issue regulations implementing the amendments
15 made by section 1 not later than the expiration of the 90-
16 day period beginning on the date of the enactment of this
17 Act. The regulations may not take effect until after Sep-
18 tember 30, 1994.

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
