AN ACT

To amend the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 to require the release of relevant information to protect the public from sexually violent offenders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as “Megan’s Law”.

3 **SEC. 2. RELEASE OF INFORMATION AND CLARIFICATION**
4 **OF PUBLIC NATURE OF INFORMATION.**

5 Section 170101(d) of the Violent Crime Control and
6 Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (42 U.S.C. 14071(d)) is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 “(d) RELEASE OF INFORMATION.—

9 “(1) The information collected under a State
10 registration program may be disclosed for any pur-
11 pose permitted under the laws of the State.

12 “(2) The designated State law enforcement
13 agency and any local law enforcement agency au-
14 thorized by the State agency shall release relevant
15 information that is necessary to protect the public
16 concerning a specific person required to register
17 under this section, except that the identity of a vic-
18 tim of an offense that requires registration under
19 this section shall not be released.”.
