A BILL

To disapprove certain sentencing guideline amendments.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DISAPPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS RELATING TO**  
2 **EQUALIZATION OF CRACK AND COCAINE**  
3 **POWDER QUANTITIES FOR TRAFFICKING OF-**  
4 **FENSES.**

5 In accordance with section 994(p) of title 28, United  
6 States Code, Amendment number 5 of the “Amendments  
7 to the Sentencing Guidelines, Policy Statements, and Offi-  
8 cial Commentary”, submitted by the United States Sen-  
9 tencing Commission to Congress on May 1, 1995, is here-  
10 by disapproved and shall not take effect to the extent it—

11 (1) amends §2D1.1(c) (1) through (14) of the  
12 sentencing guidelines;

13 (2) inserts the following sentence in §2D1.1(c)  
14 of the sentencing guidelines: “ ‘Cocaine,’ for the  
15 purposes of this guideline, includes cocaine hydro-  
16 chloride, cocaine base, and crack cocaine.”; and

17 (3) deletes “1 gm of Cocaine Base (‘Crack’) =  
18 20 kg of marihuana” from the Commentary to  
19 §2D1.1 of the sentencing guidelines captioned “Ap-  
20 plication Notes” in Note 10 in the subdivision cap-  
21 tioned “Cocaine and Other Schedule I and II Stimu-  
22 lants”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISAPPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS RELATING TO**  
2 **EQUALIZATION OF CRACK AND COCAINE**  
3 **POWER QUANTITIES FOR POSSESSION OF-**  
4 **FENSES.**

5 In accordance with section 994(p) of title 28, United  
6 States Code, Amendment number 5 of the “Amendments  
7 to the Sentencing Guidelines, Policy Statements, and Offi-  
8 cial Commentary”, submitted by the United States Sen-  
9 tencing Commission to Congress on May 1, 1995, is here-  
10 by disapproved and shall not take effect to the extent it  
11 amends section 2D2.1.

12 **SEC. 3. DISAPPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS RELATING TO**  
13 **MONEY LAUNDERING AND TRANSACTIONS IN**  
14 **PROPERTY DERIVED FROM UNLAWFUL AC-**  
15 **TIVITY.**

16 In accordance with section 994(p) of title 28, United  
17 States Code, Amendment number 18 of the “Amendments  
18 to the Sentencing Guidelines, Policy Statements, and Offi-  
19 cial Commentary”, submitted by the United States Sen-  
20 tencing Commission to Congress on May 1, 1995, is here-  
21 by disapproved and shall not take effect.
