A BILL

To prohibit the regulation of any tobacco products, or tobacco sponsored advertising, used or purchased by the National Association of Stock Car Automobile Racing, its agents or affiliates, or any other professional motor sports association by the Secretary of Health and Human Services or any other instrumentality of the Federal Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION.**

2 The Secretary of Health and Human Services or any
3 other official or instrumentality of the Federal Govern-
4 ment shall not regulate the use of tobacco or tobacco prod-
5 ucts, used or purchased by the National Association of
6 Stock Car Automobile Racing, its agents or affiliates, or
7 any other professional motor sports association under the
8 Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and shall not take
9 any action with respect to tobacco, tobacco products, or
10 tobacco advertising used by the National Association of
11 Stock Car Automobile Racing, its agents or affiliates, or
12 any other professional motor sports association under the
13 Federal Cigarette Labeling and Advertising Act or the
14 Comprehensive Smokeless Tobacco Health and Education
15 Act of 1986.
