Mr. DEFAZIO introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Oversight

## A BILL

To require Members of the House of Representatives to keep a public record of visits by lobbyists.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. RECORD OF VISITS BY LOBBYISTS.—

4 Each Member of the House of the House of Representa-  
5 tives and the Senate shall keep a record available to any  
6 member of the public, in which shall be recorded each visit  
7 to such Member by an individual who is registered under  
8 section 308 of the Federal Regulation of Lobbying Act (2  
9 U.S.C. 267). Such record shall include the date of the visit  
10 recorded, the name and affiliation of the individual who

1 made the visit, and the subject of the visit to such Mem-  
2 ber. At the end of each calendar quarter, such record shall  
3 be transmitted to the Clerk of the House of Representa-  
4 tives.

5       SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.—Section 1 shall take ef-  
6 fect on January 1, 1996.
