- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SUBSTITUTION OF TIMBER FOR CANCELED
- 4 TIMBER SALE.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding the provisions of
- 6 the Act of July 31, 1947 (30 U.S.C. 601 et seq.), and
- 7 the requirements of section 5402.0-6 of title 43, Code of
- 8 Federal Regulations, the Secretary of the Interior, acting
- 9 through the Bureau of Land Management, is authorized

- 1 to substitute, without competition, a contract for timber
- 2 identified for harvest located on public lands administered
- 3 by the Bureau of Land Management in the State of Cali-
- 4 fornia of comparable value for the following terminated
- 5 timber contract: Elkhorn Ridge Timber Sale, Contract No.
- 6 CA-050-TS-88-01.
- 7 (b) DISCLAIMER.—Nothing in this section shall be
- 8 construed as changing any law or policy of the Federal
- 9 Government beyond the timber sale substitution specified
- 10 in this section.
