A BILL

To amend section 1114 of title 18, United States Code, to extend its protections to United States Customs Service employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Customs
5 Service Employees Protection Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION FOR UNITED STATES CUSTOMS SERV-**
7 **ICE EMPLOYEES.**

8 Section 1114 of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended—

10 (1) by striking “of the customs or”; and

1 (2) by inserting “any Inspector, Agent, Canine
2 Enforcement Officer, or other employee of the
3 United States Customs Service or any person assist-
4 ing any employee of such Service in the execution of
5 that employee’s duties,” before “any immigration of-
6 ficer”.
