 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 That section 2301(a) of title 38, United States Code, is4 amended—

- 5 (1)(A) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) 6 through (C) of paragraph (1) as clauses (i) through 7 (iii), respectively; and
- 8 (B) by redesignating paragraphs (1) and (2) as 9 subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively;

(2) by inserting ''(1)'' after ''(a)'';
(3) in paragraph (1), as designated by para-
graph (2) of this section, by striking out ''to drape
the casket of" and inserting in lieu thereof ", of the
style designated under paragraph (2), with respect
to''; and
(4) by adding at the end thereof the following
new paragraph:
(1) shall (1) shall
be—
"(A) a flag to drape the casket of the deceased
veteran involved; or
''(B) a flag of a size determined by the Sec-
retary to be appropriate for mounting and display on
an interior or exterior wall, together with such mate-
rials as the Secretary determines to be necessary for
such mounting and display;
as designated by the person entitled to receive such flag
under this section.".
