2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AIR BAG MODULES.**

4 Section 33101(6) of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (K) and
7 (L) as subparagraphs (L) and (M), respectively; and

8 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (J) the fol-
9 lowing:

“(K) each air bag module;”.
