A BILL

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To ensure that payments during fiscal year 1996 of compensation for veterans with service-connected disabilities, of dependency and indemnity compensation for survivors of such veterans, and of other veterans benefits, and payments to Department of Veterans Affairs contractors providing services directly related to patient health and safety, are made regardless of Government financial shortfalls.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. ENSURED PAYMENT DURING FISCAL YEAR 1996
 OF VETERANS' BENEFITS IN EVENT OF LACK
 OF APPROPRIATIONS.
 (a) PAYMENTS REQUIRED.—In any case during fiscal

7 year 1996 in which appropriations are not otherwise avail8 able for programs, projects, and activities of the Depart9 ment of Veterans Affairs, the Secretary of Veterans Af10 fairs shall nevertheless ensure that—

(1) payments of existing veterans' benefits are
made in accordance with regular procedures and
schedules and in accordance with eligibility requirements for such benefits; and

15 (2) payments to contractors of the Veterans
16 Health Administration of the Department of Veter17 ans Affairs are made when due in the case of serv-

ices provided that directly relate to patient health
 and safety.

(b) FUNDING.—There is hereby appropriated such 3 sums as may be necessary for the payments pursuant to 4 5 subsection (a), including such amounts as may be necessary for the costs of administration of such payments. 6 7 (c) CHARGING OF ACCOUNTS WHEN APPROPRIA-8 TIONS MADE.—In any case in which the Secretary uses 9 the authority of subsection (a) to make payments, applica-10 ble accounts shall be charged for amounts so paid, and for the costs of administration of such payments, when 11 regular appropriations become available for those pur-12 13 poses.

(d) EXISTING BENEFITS SPECIFIED.—For purposes
of this section, existing veterans' benefits are benefits
under laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs that have been adjudicated and authorized for payment as of—

19 (1) December 15, 1995; or

(2) if appropriations for such benefits are available (other than pursuant to subsection (b)) after
December 15, 1995, the last day on which appropriations for payment of such benefits are available
(other than pursuant to subsection (b)).

SEC. 2. ENSURED PAYMENT DURING FISCAL YEAR 1996 OF VETERANS' BENEFITS IN EVENT DEBT CEIL ING LIMIT IS REACHED.

4 (a) PAYMENTS REQUIRED.—In any case during fiscal 5 year 1996 in which certain functions of the Government are delayed, deferred, or canceled due to a limitation on 6 7 the ability of the Government to borrow funds, the Sec-8 retary of Veterans Affairs shall nevertheless ensure that 9 payments of existing veterans' benefits are made in accordance with regular procedures and schedules and in ac-10 11 cordance with eligibility requirements for such benefits, and receipts and disbursements of the Government shall 12 13 be managed so as to ensure that the requirement imposed by this section on the Secretary is complied with. 14

15 (b) EXISTING BENEFITS SPECIFIED.—For purposes 16 of this section, existing veterans' benefits are benefits under laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Af-17 18 fairs that have been adjudicated and authorized for pay-19 ment as of the day on which it becomes necessary for certain functions of the Government to be delayed, deferred, 20 or canceled due to a limitation on the ability of the Gov-21 22 ernment to borrow funds.
