4 TRAVEL OUTSIDE UNITED STATES BY MEM5 BERS OF CONGRESS DURING ANY PERIOD OF
6 LAPSED APPROPRIATIONS.

7 No official funds may be used for travel by a Member8 of Congress outside the United States in any period dur-

ing which there is a lapse in appropriations for any Fed eral department or agency as a result of a failure to enact
 a regular appropriations bill or a continuing resolution.

## 4 SEC. 2. DEFINITION.

5 As used in this Act, the term "Member of Congress"
6 means a Senator or Representative in, or a Delegate or
7 Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
