A BILL

To prohibit use of official funds for travel outside the United States by Members of Congress during any period of lapsed appropriations as a result of a failure to enact a regular appropriations bill or continuing resolution.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF USE OF OFFICIAL FUNDS FOR**
4 **TRAVEL OUTSIDE UNITED STATES BY MEM-**
5 **BERS OF CONGRESS DURING ANY PERIOD OF**
6 **LAPSED APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 No official funds may be used for travel by a Member
8 of Congress outside the United States in any period dur-

1 ing which there is a lapse in appropriations for any Fed-
2 eral department or agency as a result of a failure to enact
3 a regular appropriations bill or a continuing resolution.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

5 As used in this Act, the term “Member of Congress”
6 means a Senator or Representative in, or a Delegate or
7 Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
