3 SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICE BY

- 4 FEDERAL EMPLOYEES PERFORMED DURING
- 5 **PERIODS OF LAPSED APPROPRIATIONS.**

For any period, during fiscal year 1996 or any subsequent fiscal year, for which there is a lapse in appropria8 tions for any agency or instrumentality of the Federal

Government or the District of Columbia (other than ap-1 propriations provided by this section) as a result of a fail-2 3 ure to enact legislation (in the form of a regular appro-4 priations Act or a continuing resolution) making funds 5 available for compensation of officers or employees for service performed during such period, there is hereby ap-6 7 propriated to such agency or instrumentality, from 8 amounts otherwise available in the general fund of the 9 Treasury, such sums as are necessary to provide com-10 pensation, at the regular rate of compensation, for such officers or employees for any such service which is of the 11 12 type described in section 1342 of title 31, United States 13 Code (including any service performed pursuant to expressed or implied authority of law, as defined in opinions 14 15 issued by the Attorney General before the date of the enactment of this Act). 16

17 SEC. 2. CHARGE TO APPLICABLE ACCOUNTS.

18 Expenditures made pursuant to this Act shall be 19 charged to the applicable appropriation, fund, or author-20 ization whenever a bill or joint resolution in which such 21 applicable appropriation, fund, or authorization is con-22 tained is enacted into law.

1 SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY.

2 The provisions of this Act shall apply with respect
3 to service (described in section 1) performed before, on,
4 or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
