- 3 SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN MINORS FOR BURIAL
- 4 IN NATIONAL CEMETERIES.
- 5 (a) Eligibility.—Paragraph (5) of section 2402 of
- 6 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
- 7 end thereof the following: "For purposes of this para-
- 8 graph, a 'minor child' is a child under 21 years of age,
- 9 or under 23 years of age if pursuing a program of edu-
- 10 cation at an educational institution, and those terms have

- 1 the meaning as defined in sections 3452 (b) and (c) of
- 2 this title.".
- 3 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 101(4)(A)
- 4 of such title is amended by striking out "chapter 19" and
- 5 inserting in lieu thereof "chapters 19 and 24".
