- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

l section 1. reimbursement of certain attorney

- 2 FEES AND COSTS.
- 3 (a) In General.—The Secretary of the Treasury
- 4 shall pay, from amounts in the Treasury not otherwise ap-
- 5 propriated, such sums as are necessary to reimburse
- 6 former employees of the White House Travel Office whose
- 7 employment in that Office was terminated on May 19,
- 8 1993, for any attorney fees and costs they incurred with
- 9 respect to that termination.
- 10 (b) Verification Required.—The Secretary shall
- 11 pay an individual in full under subsection (a) upon sub-
- 12 mission by the individual of documentation verifying the
- 13 attorney fees and costs.
- 14 (c) No Inference of Liability.—Liability of the
- 15 United States shall not be inferred from enactment of or
- 16 payment under this section.
- 17 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FILING OF CLAIMS.
- The Secretary of the Treasury shall not pay any
- 19 claim filed under this Act that is filed later than 120 days
- 20 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 21 SEC. 3. REDUCTION.
- The amount paid pursuant to this Act to an individ-
- 23 ual for attorney fees and costs described in section 1 shall
- 24 be reduced by any amount received before the date of the
- 25 enactment of this Act, without obligation for repayment
- 26 by the individual, for payment of such attorney fees and

- 1 costs (including any amount received from the funds ap-
- 2 propriated for the individual in the matter relating to the
- 3 "Office of the General Counsel" under the heading "Office
- 4 of the Secretary" in title I of the Department of Transpor-
- 5 tation and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 1994).

6 SEC. 4. PAYMENT IN FULL SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS

- 7 AGAINST THE UNITED STATES.
- 8 Payment under this Act, when accepted by an indi-
- 9 vidual described in section 1, shall be in full satisfaction
- 10 of all claims of, or on behalf of, the individual against the
- 11 United States that arose out of the termination of the
- 12 White House Travel Office employment of that individual
- 13 on May 19, 1993.
