A BILL

 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.

- 4 Congress finds that—
- 5 (1) the construction of a dam on the North
 6 Fork of the American River at Auburn, California
 7 was rejected by Congress on September 23, 1993,
 8 when a bipartisan majority of the House of Rep-

resentatives voted 273–140 to delete a proposed au thorization for Federal appropriations for such con struction; and

4 (2) the Federal funding share for such con5 struction would cost Federal taxpayers hundreds of
6 millions of dollars—a Federal expenditure that is
7 not affordable or justifiable.

8 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING.

9 (a) PROHIBITION ON USE.—No funds appropriated 10 to or made available to the Secretary of the Army or the 11 Secretary of the Interior before, on, or after the date of 12 the enactment of this Act may be obligated or expended 13 to construct a dam on the North Fork of the American 14 River at Auburn, California.

(b) PROHIBITION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—No funds
may be appropriated or made available for construction
of a dam on the North Fork of the American River at
Auburn, California.
