## A BILL

To deauthorize a portion of the navigation project for  
Weymouth-Fore and Town Rivers, Massachusetts.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That the following 35-foot deep channel portion of the  
4 project for navigation, Weymouth-Fore and Town Rivers,  
5 Massachusetts, authorized by section 301 of the River and  
6 Harbor Act of 1965 (79 Stat. 1089), is not authorized  
7 after the date of the enactment of this Act: Beginning at  
8 a bend on the southern limit of the existing project,  
9 N457,394.01, E741,109.74, thence running westerly  
10 about 405.25 feet to a point, N457,334.64, E740,708.86,

1 thence running southwesterly about 462.60 feet to another  
2 bend in the southern limit of the existing project,  
3 N457,132.00, E740,293.00, thence running northeasterly  
4 about 857.74 feet along the southern limit of the existing  
5 project to the point of origin.
