Mr. BILBRAY (for himself, Mr. MOORHEAD, Mr. PACKARD, Mr. HUNTER, Mr. CUNNINGHAM, Mr. THOMAS, Mr. YOUNG of Alaska, Mr. SCHAEFER, and Mr. BARTON of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Commerce

A BILL

To direct a property conveyance in the State of California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ward Valley Land
5 Transfer Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY.**

7 Effective upon the tendering to the Secretary of the
8 Treasury of \$500,100 on behalf of the State of California
9 and the tendering to the Chairman of the Nuclear Regu-
10 latory Commission of a written commitment by the State
11 to carry out environmental monitoring and protection

1 measures based on recommendations of the National
2 Academy of Sciences subject to Federal oversight by the
3 Nuclear Regulatory Commission pursuant to 42 U.S.C.
4 2021, as amended, all right, title, and interest of the Unit-
5 ed States in the property depicted on a map designated
6 USGS 7.5 minute quadrangle, west of Flattop Mountain,
7 CA 1984, entitled “Location Map for Ward Valley Site”,
8 located in San Bernardino Meridian, Township 9 North,
9 Range 19 East, and improvements thereon, together with
10 all necessary easements for utilities and ingress and egress
11 to such property, including, but not limited to, the right
12 to improve those easements, are conveyed by operation of
13 law to the Department of Health Services of the State of
14 California. Upon the request of the State of California,
15 the Secretary of the Interior shall provide evidence of title
16 transfer.
