- 7 U.S.C. 405(c)(2) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (F) and 2 (G) as subparagraphs (G) and (H), respectively; and 3 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (E) the following new subparagraph: "(E) Any judgment, decree, or order issued by a 5 court of competent jurisdiction to the Social Security Ad-6 ministration shall be treated as an order meeting the re-8 quirements for disclosure under section 552a(b)(11) of title 5, United States Code, to the extent the judgment, 10 decree, or order requires disclosure of an individual's So-11 cial Security account number or any other record main-12 tained by the Social Security Administration pertaining to 13 an individual. Any such order shall not be treated as pre-14 cluded by any determination that the need for the disclo-15 sure is inadequate on the basis of any invasion of privacy 16 which might result from such order.".

17 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The amendment made by section 1 shall apply with respect to judgments, decrees, and orders issued by courts of competent jurisdiction on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
