1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Government Account-
- 3 ability Act of 1996".
- 4 SEC. 2. RESTORATION OF FALSE STATEMENT PENALTIES.
- 5 Section 1001 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:

7 "§ 1001. Statements or entries generally

- 8 "(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 9 whoever, in any matter within the jurisdiction of the exec-
- 10 utive, legislative, or judicial branch of the Government of
- 11 the United States, knowingly and willfully—
- "(1) falsifies, conceals, or covers up by any
- trick, scheme, or device a material fact;
- 14 "(2) makes any materially false, fictitious, or
- fraudulent statement or representation; or
- 16 "(3) makes or uses any false writing or docu-
- ment knowing the same to contain any materially
- false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or entry;
- 19 shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than
- 20 5 years, or both.
- 21 "(b) Subsection (a) does not apply—
- 22 "(1) to a party to a judicial proceeding, or that
- party's counsel, for statements, representations,
- 24 writings or documents submitted by such party or
- counsel to a judge in that proceeding; or
- 26 "(2) to—

1	"(A) any non-administrative matter; or
2	"(B) any investigative matter, other than
3	with respect to a person furnishing information
4	pursuant to a duly authorized investigation;
5	within the jurisdiction of an entity within the legisla-
6	tive branch.".
