  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 That section 31306 of title 49, United States Code, is
  - 4 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
  - 5 section:
  - 6 "(k) Exemption.—The Secretary shall not require
  - 7 the testing for the use of alcohol or a controlled substance

of an operator of a motor vehicle described in section 2 31301(4)(A) if the vehicle— 3 "(1) is owned or controlled by an owner or operator of a farm and is used solely to provide, within 4 a 150 air mile radius of the farm, not-for-hire trans-5 portation of agricultural commodities and farm sup-6 plies to and from the farm; or 7 "(2) is being used to provide not-for-hire trans-8 portation of property for a unit of a local govern-9 ment that has jurisdiction over an area with a popu-10 lation of less than 7,500.". 11
