Mr. COMBEST introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to limit the applicability of hazardous material transportation registration and fee requirements for persons who offer crude oil and condensate for transport in commerce, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Crude Oil Transpor-
5 tation Fairness Act of 1996”.

1 **SEC. 2. HAZARDOUS MATERIAL TRANSPORTATION REG-**
2 **ISTRATION AND FEE REQUIREMENTS.**

3 Section 5108(a) of title 49, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(5)(A) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
6 a person who offers crude oil and condensate for transport
7 in commerce shall not be required to file a registration
8 statement or pay a fee otherwise required under this sec-
9 tion if the person transfers title to the crude oil to the
10 transporter at the time that the crude oil is initially trans-
11 ported in commerce from a storage location by the trans-
12 porter.

13 “(B) Subparagraph (A) does not apply to any person
14 who transports crude oil and condensate in commerce in
15 a quantity that is subject to the requirements of this sec-
16 tion.”.

17 **SEC. 3. MAXIMUM ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE.**

18 The second sentence of section 5108(g)(2)(A) of title
19 49, United States Code, is amended by striking “at least
20 \$250 but not more than \$5,000” and inserting “not more
21 than \$250”.
