## A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to reduce certain funds if eligible States do not enact certain laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANT REDUCTION.**

4 Section 506 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control  
5 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 is amended by adding at  
6 the end the following:

7 “(g) In order not to reduce the funds available under  
8 this subpart by 50 percent (for redistribution to other par-  
9 ticipating States), a State shall, on the first day of each  
10 fiscal year succeeding the first fiscal year beginning after

1 September 30, 1998, meet the following requirements:

2 Have in effect throughout the State in such fiscal year

3 a law which—

4           “(1) makes it unlawful for a person to attempt

5           to murder a woman whom the person knows is preg-

6           nant if death of the fetus results; and

7           “(2) provides a sentence of not less than 30

8           years in prison and may be life imprisonment.”.
