## A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to reduce certain funds if eligible States do not enact certain laws.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. GRANT REDUCTION.
- 4 Section 506 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control
- 5 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 is amended by adding at
- 6 the end the following:
- 7 "(g) In order not to reduce the funds available under
- 8 this subpart by 50 percent (for redistribution to other par-
- 9 ticipating States), a State shall, on the first day of each
- 10 fiscal year succeeding the first fiscal year beginning after

- 1 September 30, 1998, meet the following requirements:
- 2 Have in effect throughout the State in such fiscal year
- 3 a law which—
- 4 "(1) makes it unlawful for a person to attempt
- 5 to murder a woman whom the person knows is preg-
- 6 nant if death of the fetus results; and
- 7 "(2) provides a sentence of not less than 30
- 8 years in prison and may be life imprisonment.".
