A BILL

To redesignate the Herbert Clark Hoover Department of Commerce Building located at 14th Street and Constitution Avenue NW., in Washington, DC, as the “Ronald H. Brown Commerce Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 14th Street and Con-
5 stitution Avenue NW., in Washington, DC, and known as
6 the Herbert Clark Hoover Department of Commerce
7 Building, shall be known and designated as the “Ronald
8 H. Brown Commerce Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “Ronald H. Brown Commerce Build-
6 ing”.
