## A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the minimum wage rate under that Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Minimum Wage In-  
5 crease Act of 1996”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN MINIMUM WAGE.**

2 Paragraph (1) of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor  
3 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)) is amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 “(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-  
6 tion, not less than \$4.25 an hour during the period  
7 ending 90 days after the date of the enactment of  
8 the Minimum Wage Increase Act of 1996, not less  
9 than \$4.75 an hour during the year beginning on  
10 that date, and not less than \$5.25 an hour after the  
11 expiration of such year;”.
