A BILL

To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1997 for certain maritime programs of the Department of Transportation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Maritime Administra-
5 tion Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1997”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL**
7 **YEAR 1997.**

8 Funds are authorized to be appropriated without fis-
9 cal year limitation, as Appropriations Acts may provide

1 for the use of the Department of Transportation, for the
2 fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, as follows:

3 (a) For expenses necessary for operations and
4 training activities, not to exceed \$78,097,000.

5 (b) For the costs, as defined in section 502 of
6 the Federal Credit Reform Act of 1990, of guaran-
7 teed loans authorized by title XI of the Merchant
8 Marine Act, 1936, as amended (46 App. U.S.C.
9 1271 et seq.), \$40,000,000. In addition, for adminis-
10 trative expenses related to loan guarantee commit-
11 ments under title XI of the Merchant Marine Act,
12 1936, as amended (46 App. U.S.C. 1271 et seq.),
13 \$4,000,000.
