## A BILL

To provide for the recoupment to the Highway Trust Fund of that portion of federal motor fuel taxes being deposited into the General Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gasoline Tax Restitu-  
5 tion Act of 1996”.

6 **SEC. 2. RECOUPMENT OF MOTOR FUEL TAXES TO HIGHWAY**  
7 **TRUST FUND.**

8 (a) REFERENCES.—References in this Act shall be  
9 considered to be made to a section of the Internal Revenue  
10 Code of 1986.

1       (b) RECOUPMENT.—Notwithstanding any provision  
2 of law to the contrary, there are hereby appropriated to  
3 the Highway Trust Fund (established pursuant to section  
4 9503) amounts equivalent to the taxes received in the  
5 Treasury under section 4081 (relating to tax on gasoline  
6 and diesel fuel) and such other applicable sections, that,  
7 on the date immediately prior to the date of enactment  
8 of this Act, are not being so appropriated or credited. The  
9 amount of such taxes shall not exceed 4.3 cents per gallon.
