## A BILL

To repeal the requirement that ships' stores of the Navy be operated as nonappropriated fund instrumentalities.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the "Ships' Stores Funding  
5       Act of 1995".

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF NAFI REQUIREMENT FOR SHIPS'**  
2 **STORES.**

3 (a) REPEAL.—Subsections (a) and (b) of section 371  
4 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year  
5 1994 (Public Law 103–160; 107 Stat. 1634) are repealed.

6 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subsection (d) of  
7 such section is amended by striking out “the date on  
8 which the Secretary of the Navy completes the conversion  
9 referred to in subsection (a)” and inserting in lieu thereof  
10 “the date of the enactment of the Ships’ Stores Funding  
11 Act of 1995”.
