## A BILL

1	SECTION 1. REBURIAL OF UNKNOWN SOLDIERS FROM
2	CIVIL WAR IN THE MEMORIAL AMPHI-
3	THEATER OF ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEME-
4	TERY.
5	The Secretary of Defense is authorized and directed
6	to cause to be brought from a National Cemetery for bur-
7	ial in the Memorial Amphitheater of the National Ceme-
8	tery at Arlington, Virginia, the remains of—
9	(1) an American who was a member of the
10	Union Army of the United States, who served in the
11	Civil War of 1861 through 1865 who lost his life
12	during the Civil War, and whose identity has not
13	been established; and
14	(2) an American who was a member of the
15	Army of the Confederate States of America, who
16	served in the Civil War of 1861 through 1865 who
17	lost his life during the Civil War, and whose identity
18	has not been established.
19	SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
20	There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
21	as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this
22	Act.
