- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REBURIAL OF UNKNOWN SOLDIER FROM CIVIL
- 4 WAR IN THE MEMORIAL AMPHITHEATER OF
- 5 ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY.
- 6 The Secretary of Defense is authorized and directed
- 7 to cause to be brought from a National Cemetery the re-

- 1 mains of an American who was a member of the Union
- 2 Army of the United States, who served in the Civil War
- 3 of 1861 through 1865 who lost his life during the Civil
- 4 War, and whose identity has not been established, for bur-
- 5 ial in the Memorial Amphitheater of the National Ceme-
- 6 tery at Arlington, Virginia.

7 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- 8 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
- 9 as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this
