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## A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF 75/25 MEDICAID ENROLLMENT**  
4 **RULE FOR CERTAIN MANAGED CARE ORGANI-**  
5 **ZATIONS.**

6 The requirement of section 1903(m)(2)(A)(ii) of the  
7 Social Security Act is waived—

8 (1) with respect to Catholic Health Services  
9 Plan of Brooklyn and Queens, Inc. (doing business  
10 as Fidelis Health Plan) and Managed Healthcare

1       Systems of New York, Inc., for contract periods  
2       through January 1, 1999, and  
3               (2) with respect to Health Partners of Philadel-  
4       phia, Inc., for contract periods through December  
5       31, 1999.

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
