4 The requirement of section 1903(m)(2)(A)(ii) of the

5 Social Security Act is waived—

6 (1) with respect to Catholic Health Services

7 Plan of Brooklyn and Queens, Inc. (doing business

8 as Fidelis Health Plan) and Managed Healthcare

9 Systems of New York, Inc., for contract periods

10 through January 1, 1999, and

11 (2) with respect to Health Partners of Philadel-

12 phia, Inc., for contract periods through December

13 31, 1999.



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
