- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Repeal of the 9-Term
- 5 Clause Act".

1 SEC. 2. REPEAL.

- 2 (a) In General.—The last sentence of subsection
- 3 (g) of section 8336 of title 5, United States Code, is
- 4 amended—
- 5 (1) by striking "(1)"; and
- 6 (2) by striking "or (2) serving in 9 Con-
- 7 gresses".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—This section and the amend-
- 9 ments made by this section—
- 10 (1) shall take effect at the beginning of the
- 11 105th Congress; and
- 12 (2) shall apply with respect to separations oc-
- curring during the 105th Congress or later.
