## A BILL

To amend the Fair Housing Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Housing Reform
- 5 and Freedom of Speech Act of 1996".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING ACT.
- 7 (a) In General.—The first sentence of section
- 8 807(b)(1) of the Fair Housing Act (42 U.S.C. 3607(b)(1))
- 9 is amended by inserting before the period the following:
- 10 ", including any restriction relating to the maximum num-
- 11 ber of unrelated persons permitted to occupy a dwelling,
- 12 governing the proximity of dwellings to each other, or the

- 1 occupancy of a dwelling by a convicted felon, sex offender,
- 2 or recovering drug addict, if the purpose of the restriction
- 3 is to restrict land use to single family dwellings".
- 4 (b) Protection of Certain Activities.—Title I
- 5 of the Fair Housing Act (42 U.S.C. 3601 et seq.) is
- 6 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

## 7 "SEC. 821. PROTECTION OF CERTAIN ACTIVITIES.

- 8 "Nothing in this Act shall be construed to apply to
- 9 any otherwise lawful activity engaged in by one or more
- 10 persons, including the filing or maintaining of a legal ac-
- 11 tion, that is engaged in solely for the purpose of—
- 12 "(1) achieving or preventing action by a govern-
- mental entity or official; or
- 14 "(2) receiving an interpretation of any provision
- of this Act in a court of competent jurisdiction.".
