- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Food Stamp Conver-
- 5 sion and Profiteering Prohibition Act of 1996".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.
- 7 Section 6(b)(1) of the Food Stamp Act of 1977 (7
- 8 U.S.C. 2015(b)(1)) is amended—
- 9 (1) by striking "or (B)" and inserting "(B)",
- 10 and

- 1 (2) by inserting ", or (C) using food acquired
- with coupons to acquire anything other than food,"
- 3 after "cards".

### 4 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 5 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
- 6 take effect on the first day of the first month beginning
- 7 more than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this
- 8 Act.
