# TITLE III—CLAIBORNE PELL IN STITUTE FOR INTER NATIONAL RELATIONS AND PUBLIC POLICY

5 SEC. 301. SHORT TITLE.

6 This title may be cited as the "Claiborne Pell Institute
7 for International Relations and Public Policy Act".

#### 8 SEC. 302. GRANT AUTHORIZED.

9 In recognition of the public service of Senator Clai-10 borne Pell, the Secretary of Education is authorized to 11 award a grant, in accordance with the provisions of this title, to assist in the establishment and operation of the 12 Claiborne Pell Institute for International Relations and 13 14 Public Policy, located as Salve Regina University, Newport, Rhode Island, including the purchase and renovation of fa-15 cilities to house the Institute. 16

#### 17 SEC. 303. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

18 There are authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year
19 1997 such sums, not to exceed \$3,000,000, as may be nec20 essary to carry out this title.

#### 21 SEC. 304. EFFECTIVE DATE.

22 This title shall take effect on the date of enactment of23 this Act.

## *TITLE IV—GEORGE BUSH SCHOOL OF GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC SERVICE*

#### 4 SEC. 401. SHORT TITLE.

5 This title may be cited as the "George Bush School6 of Government and Public Service Act".

#### 7 SEC. 402. GRANT AUTHORIZED.

8 In recognition of the public service of President George 9 Bush, the Secretary of Education is authorized to make a 10 grant in accordance with the provisions of this Act to assist 11 in the establishment of the George Bush Fellowship Pro-12 gram, located at the George Bush School of Government and 13 Public Service of the Texas A & M University.

#### 14 SEC. 403. GRANT CONDITIONS.

No payment may be made under this title except upon
an application at such time, in such manner, and containing or accompanied by such information as the Secretary
of Education may require.

#### 19 SEC. 404. APPROPRIATIONS AUTHORIZED.

20 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums, not
21 to exceed \$3,000,000, as may be necessary to carry out the
22 provisions of this title.

#### 23 SEC. 405. EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 This title shall take effect on October 1, 1996.

#### TITLE V—MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

4 In recognition of the public service of Senator and Secretary of State Edmund S. Muskie, the Secretary of Edu-5 cation is authorized to award a grant in accordance with 6 the provisions of this Act to assist in the establishment of 7 8 the Edmund S. Muskie Foundation, located in Washington, 9 DC, by providing assistance to support the foundation, in-10 cluding assistance to be used for awarding stewardships, 11 supporting the Muskie archives, and supporting the Ed-12 mund S. Muskie Institute of Public Affairs.

### 13 SEC. 502. CALVIN COOLIDGE MEMORIAL FOUNDATION 14 GRANT.

15 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

16 (1) FOUNDATION.—The term "Foundation"
17 means the Calvin Coolidge Memorial Foundation.

18 (2) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
19 the Secretary of Education.

(b) GRANT AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary is authorized to make a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 in accordance with the provisions of this section to the Foundation.
(c) GRANT CONDITIONS.—
